

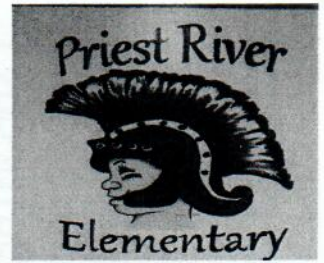
PRIEST RIVER ELEMENTARY NEWS

Priest River Elementary students and staff were able to donate over 1300 pounds of food to our local food bank at the end of March. Way to Go!! Thanks for your support!

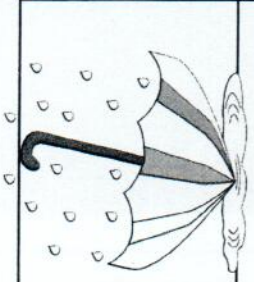
