IMPORTANT

Make sure your students(s) know their after school plan **BEFORE** coming to school. If it's different than their normal routine, send a note for their teacher, and a note for the bus driver. Policy requires a signed note from the parents for riding a bus other than their regular route. If you do not send a note to the teacher, we will send your student(s) home the regular way.

Calling the school to change plans should only be for emergency situations- and needs to be done before 1:45, otherwise we can't guarantee the message will get to your child. If you or someone else is picking up your child, please be sure to wait until the pickup time of 2:27. The office is very busy at end of day and this also allows the buses to load and leave before pickup/walker dismissal.
