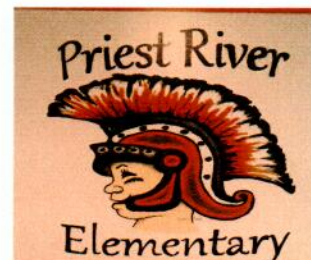


PRIEST RIVER ELEMENTARY NEWS

Celebrations.

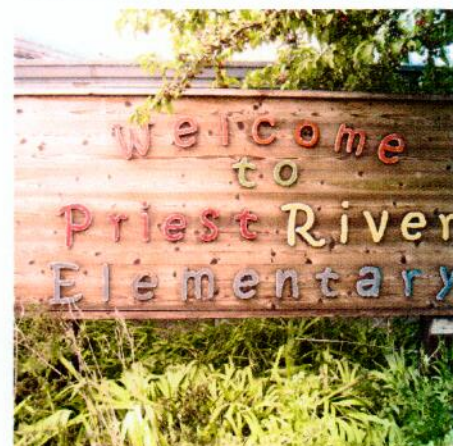
We celebrated Earth day on April 21st. We worked with the Forest Service and sent out 5th and 6th grade classes to help maintain the grounds at the Ranger station.
