Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff:

The Idaho State Board of Education met yesterday and issued new guidance to all school districts in Idaho. They issued a soft closure until April 20th. During this time students are not permitted in the schools. What this means is that school will not resume until April 20th, at the earliest. However, building principals and teachers will still be available for questions or concerns.

Our Administration team understands the impact this has on families and will continue to serve you as best possible. We will continue to serve two meals a day, during regular calendar school days. These meals can be picked up at Idaho Hill Elementary, Priest River Elementary and Priest River Junior High from 8 AM to 9 AM. These meals will be offered March 23-March 26th, April 6-April 10th and again on April 13-April 17th. If you need assistance getting your meals please contact our Food Service Director, Terri Johnson, at 208-290-2022.

Our Administration team and Board of Trustees believe it is essential to continue to provide student learning. Our schools will be open on April 8th from 8 AM – 12 PM for students to turn in required completed assignments and gather instructional materials for the remainder of the school dismissal. This will not be a school day, just an opportunity to drop off and collect instructional materials. If you are unable to make it please contact your building principals, so we can set up alternative means of delivering the work to your student. It is important that your student continues to complete all take home work, as this is essential for their education. Report cards will be mailed out on April 15th.
